June.03 . It gets support from KCF Hong Kong and AECI from Spain.</p> <p>Up to December .2008 , 1356 trainees graduated from the center and 372 is female. And 1163 are self – employed and 13 are employed. Target people are from Pusat, Kampong Cham, Steng Treng, Rathnakiri and Kratie.</p> <p>Currently, The center has provide only three skills including :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Motor Repairing skill 2. Tailoring skill 3.
